<u>Message From Rabbi Yachnes:</u>

ALWAYS HAPPY: As we enter the month of Adar, we are reminded of the words of the Kitzur Shulchan Aruch (141:1), "Mishenichnas Adar Marbim B'simcha"- "When the month of Adar begins, we increase happiness". The word "increase" implies that one should **always** be happy and just **increased** during Adar. In our Davening we say "Ivdu Es Hashem B'simcha"- "Serve Hashem with happiness", and we say those words all year long. So let's **always** be **happy**, and for the next month let's increase that happiness. Have a wonderful Shabbos and a Chodesh Tov!
