Message From Rabbi Yachnes:

DOES HASHEM NEED A REMINDER? The Torah (28:12) states that Avnei Zikaron – Remembrance Stones should be placed on the shoulder straps of the "apron" that Aharon HaKohen wore as a remembrance to the Jewish people. Rashi comments that Hashem will see the names of the tribes engraved on these stones and remember their righteousness, and thereby forgive the Jewish people. Really?! Does Hashem need a reminder? Certainly not! Rashi is teaching us that some action, some hishtadluseffort, must be performed on our part to "activate" the merits that will result from the righteousness of those tribes. Otherwise those merits may just remain dormant. "You do your best and Hashem will do the rest" May we hear only good news from Eretz Yisrael. Have a wonderful Shabbos.
