HOLD YOUR FIRE! "Don't kindle a fire on Shabbos" (35:3). The Sh'la HaKadosh says that this refers also to the fire of anger which must be avoided on the day of Shabbos. Rav Eliyahu Lopian adds that Erev Shabbos is also included in this mandate since everyone is rushing to prepare and as a result angers may flare. So be careful and hold your fire. May we hear only good news from Eretz Yisroel. Have a wonderful Shabbos!
