ALWAYS CONSULT: The Medrash (Yalkut Shimoni 524:20) says that Nadav and Avihu sinned by not consulting with each other about bringing an offering that Hashem had not instructed them to bring. But why should they? They were both great Tzaddikim and they each separately came to the very same conclusion? Rav Henoch Leibowitz zt'l explained that seeking advice, consulting and discussion, clarify and crystallize matters which may result in people seeing things differently. And this is true whether the other person is greater, equal, or of lesser greatness. Always consult! May we hear only good news from Eretz Yisroel. Have a wonderful Shabbos.






