Message From Rabbi Yachnes:

IT'S A PROCESS: Rebbe Akiva begins his journey to greatness while sitting at a river bank and seeing cracks and crevices in the rocks formed by the rushing waters. Using basic logic, he reasoned that if water which is soft can penetrate a rock that is strong, then Torah which is strong, can certainly penetrate the human heart that is soft, and he began to study Torah (Avos D'rebbe Nosson). However: If the same amount of water that rushed through the years was poured onto the rocks at one time, the results would not be the same because it's not the amount of water that counts, it's the **process** and **consistency** that counts. That was the keen insight of Rebbe Akiva. Anything of great value – especially Torah – requires time, patience, endurance and the recognition that **it's a process**. May we hear only good news from Eretz Yisrael. Have a wonderful Shabbos.







2nd and 3rd grade uses UNO to practice their mental math!




