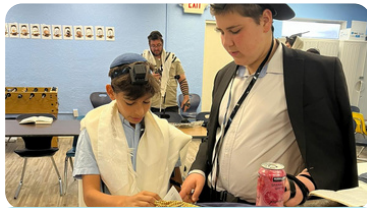

## Message From Rabbi Yachnes:

**MATZOH ANYONE?** This Wednesday (May 22; 14th of Iyar) is Pesach Sheini. For anyone who may have been tamei on the fourteenth of **Nissan** during the time of the Bais HaMikdash, and was unable to bring the Korban Pesach on that day, the fourteenth of **Iyar** was designated for that Korban to be brought. But why wait an entire month, when only two weeks is needed to become tahor? Rav Yaakov Emden explains that the amount of matzoh with which the Jews left Mitzrayim, lasted until the fourteenth of **Iyar**, implying that the miracle of Y'Tzias Mitzrayim lasted until then as well. Therefore **that** day, the **fourteenth of Iyar** was designated as Pesach Sheini. Hence the custom to eat matzoh on Pesach Sheini. May we hear only good news from Eretz Yisroel. Have a wonderful Shabbos.

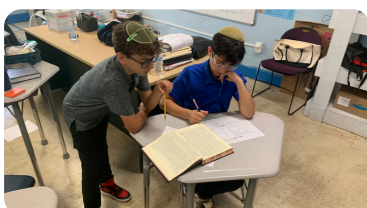

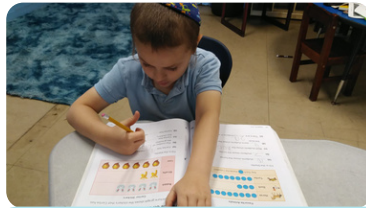

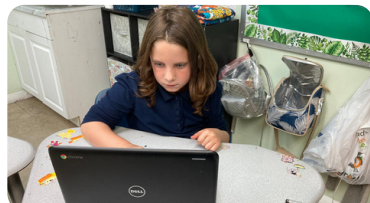
