Message From Rabbi Yachnes:

MEMORIES ARE SHORT LIVED: After enumerating all of the blessings that will be bestowed upon the Jewish people if they keep the Mitzvos, the Torah adds a passuk stating that Hashem took us out of Mitzrayim honorably (26:13). Rashi says that the reason for that additional passuk is reassure the Jewish people that they can trust that Hashem is capable of providing those blessings since He had already taken them out of Mitzrayim and performed great miracles. Really?! Did anyone actually have any doubts? Would anyone really think that Hashem is incapable of providing those blessings that He had promised, without a reminder of the miracles of Mitzrayim? YES! Memories are short lived, and the Jewish people needed to be reminded and reassured even about Hashem's capabilities. May we hear only good news from Eretz Yisrael. Have a wonderful Shabbos.
