Message From Rabbi Yachnes:

WEALTHY AND SATISFIED: If Avraham Avinu was known to be very wealthy, why then does the Torah state (Bereshis 25:8) that when he died he was "saveia" ("satisfied"), the Torah should have said "ashir" ("rich")? The Ramban answers that although the general rule is "Ohev kesef lo yisba kesef" - "One who loves money is never satisfied with the money he has," Avraham was different. He was satisfied with whatever he had and never felt that he needed more. A good quotation to remember is "Success, is having what you want, happiness, is wanting what you have". May we hear only good news from Eretz Yisroel. Have a wonderful Shabbos.


