THE WAR AGAINST ONESELF: Rashi (33:4) says that Eisav had mercy on Yaakov when he saw Yaakov bow down to him. Rav Yehudah Leib Chasman says that Yaakov knew that he could win a war against Eisav and was prepared for it, but his first strategy was to win the war against his Yetzer HaRa. It took a lot of strength and discipline for Yaakov to lower himself and bow, even referring to himself as a servant and Eisav the master, for the sake of peace. By winning that internal battle, he "won" the war against Eisav. May we hear only good news from Eretz Yisroel. Have a wonderful Shabbos.






